Whether it's the crowning glory of a lavish meal, the perfect complement to a cup of coffee or tea, or a stand-alone treat, dessert should be a blissful indulgence of the senses. And there's no time like the holidays for indulging.

But not all of us are up to the task of producing a *pièce de résistance*. So if an amateur baker lacks the requisite time, space, equipment, or know-how, professional help from the area's finest bakeries may be in order.

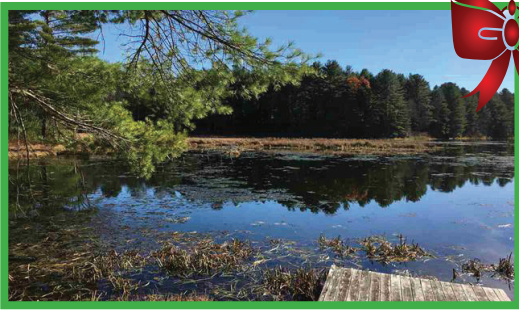
For 30 years, Carmela and Angelo have operated this family-owned Italian bakery, growing it from a single retail outlet in Monticello to wholesale supplier of breads and pastries in Orange and Sullivan counties, NY, as well as Wayne and Pike counties in Pennsylvania. Now joined by son Vincenzo, the bakery has spawned a café with a Sunday morning (11 a.m. to 2 p.m.) open-mic series featuring hot local musicians. So successful is the series that the café has been expanded to accommodate SRO crowds and will soon offer the DeFilippis' answer to Krispy Kreme: Hot Dippity Donuts, hot donuts on dipping sticks, made fresh all day and paired with lattes and cappuccinos.

In addition to traditional Thanksgiving offerings of apple, pumpkin, cherry, pecan and blueberry pies, more exotic holiday pies include mincemeat, chocolate bourbon, peanut butter cream, Oreo, chocolate cream and banana cream, plus old standbys like lemon meringue and coconut custard. And then there are lesser-known Old World specialties like *cassatta* and *gateau*, and better-known tiramisu, cannoli cake and ricotta cheesecake. For Christmas, there are also baskets and buckets of rainbow (tri-color) marzipan cookies. Patrons are urged to place orders at least one week prior to the expected pickup date.

One year after meeting in Israel, they married and settled in the New York metro area, where he made cake for Chock Full O'Nuts Corporation. The acquisition of a weekend home in Narrowsburg introduced this baker from Manchester, England and his American bride to an area where they couldn't find European-style bread. They decided to make their own, and the rest is history.

Brian Woods and Lisa Rubin-Woods have been baking here for 17 years, at first in their basement and later in a converted shed outside their home. Oddly enough, the baker whose initial focus was on recreating continental artisan bread has since mastered traditional American baking. The classic harvest pies will be available for Thanksgiving: apple, apple crumb, pumpkin, blueberry, cherry and pecan, and also a Southern specialty—Mississippi mud pie—as well as New England favorites like pumpkin and cranberry breads.

Besides making several varieties of Christmas cookies (ginger their specialty), they offer challah bread and macarons for Hanukkah. Wrapping, packing and shipping is available for some products; orders should be placed two weeks before expected delivery date.

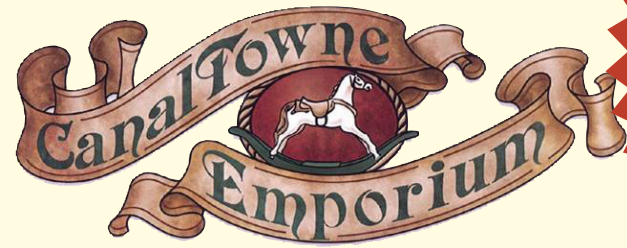

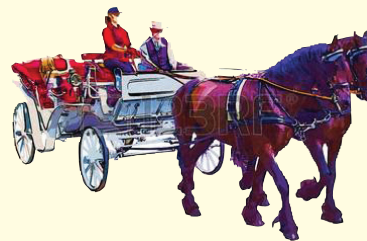

Anyone who wants to feel like a kid in a candy shop should pay a visit to this bakery, owned and operated by Sarah and Errol Flynn, she a German pastry chef and he a Kenoza Lake native. In fact, it's entirely possible to do all your holiday gift shopping here. From gingerbread houses to Christmas *stollen* (available only from November 1 to January 1), *lebkuchen* and *elisenlebkuchen* (soft, chewy chocolate-glazed cookies), and handmade Belgian chocolate bars with a variety of nuts and dried fruits, German specialty items of all kinds abound, including homemade hot chocolate mix. So much is packed into this delightful little shop that you could spend hours discovering some of what this bakery has produced during its five years in business.

For Thanksgiving, traditional pies are available, as are cranapple and mince. Christmas cookies include *peffernüsse* and gingerbread. Yule logs come in chocolate, chocolate raspberry, double chocolate, hazelnut and eggnog flavors. Christmas orders should be placed two weeks prior to expected pickup. Wrapping, packing and shipping is available for items that travel well.

Home for the Holidays

The season of entertaining is upon us! For some, this is cause for excitement. For others, it's a source of anxiety. If the thought of throwing your doors open to friends, extended family and colleagues sends you into a panic, I've got some suggestions for you. They may come in handy even if you're already the consummate host.

One thing that applies across the board is this: Don't Strive for Perfection. As a recovering perfectionist, I speak from experience when I say that this can really reduce your own pleasure. If you can't have people over because your house is not fancy enough (or clean enough), your cooking is not restaurant-quality or you can't afford extravagance, you're looking at this all wrong. Stop worrying about impressing others and instead create an occasion that is fun for you and plays to your strengths. If you mix great cocktails, start there and add small finger foods to round out your menu. Simple is fine; in fact, it's better. Guests want to visit with you, not hear you banging around in the kitchen. Serve food that can be prepared in advance or needs very little finishing.

My entertaining staples include store-bought olives that I dress up with orange zest, chile flakes, coriander seed and good olive oil; little balls of goat cheese rolled in a mix of chopped fresh herbs, sea salt and pink peppercorns; homemade crackers that are a cinch to make and never fail to wow; and some sort of addictive dip to serve with chips and crudités. My roasted carrot hummus fits the bill—creamy and full of bright flavors, but not too heavy.

Soft candlelight is flattering to everyone and hides dust like nobody's business. Add some fragrant pine boughs and a couple of jars of foraged red winterberries and you've got instant ambience. Put on some lovely music—like Handel's "Messiah" or Nat King Cole's Christmas album—and the mood turns festive. Nothing makes your house smell better than simmering spices. Toss a few cloves, a cinnamon stick and some orange peel in a pot of water and keep it on the stove for a couple of hours before your party starts.

If the weather turns cold, turn to holiday favorites like mulled wine, hot cider and eggnog. If it stays unseasonably warm, it's the perfect opportunity to make a punch. Mother's Ruin has fresh grapefruit juice, gin and vermouth topped up with sparkling water. Or prepare a batch of cocktails so you're not mixing drinks all night. The Negroni is an Italian classic made with equal parts gin, Campari and sweet vermouth. It's a festive scarlet and offers a bitter edge as a counterpoint to its herbal sweetness. For a special touch, top it off with a little prosecco. As an alcohol-free option try sorrel, a Caribbean drink made by brewing hibiscus tea with cloves, cinnamon, orange peel and fresh ginger. Strain, sweeten to taste and serve warm or over ice.

With a little planning and organization, the evening will go smoothly. Add some good conversation and plenty of laughter and everyone will go home happy. The best part? You'll already be home. So relax and have another drink...

Negroni

Makes 10 cocktails

- 10 ounces gin
- 10 ounces sweet vermouth
- 10 ounces Campari
- 1 bottle prosecco, optional
- 10 orange twists

Stir together gin, vermouth and Campari in a large pitcher. To serve, pour into ice-filled tumblers. Add a float of prosecco, if desired, and garnish with a twist.

Roasted Carrot Hummus

Serves 6-8

- 6 tablespoons olive oil, plus more for serving
- 2 teaspoons honey
- 1 teaspoon ground cumin
- 1 teaspoon ground coriander
- ½ teaspoon red chile flakes
- 1 pound carrots, trimmed and scrubbed
- 3 large unpeeled cloves garlic, smashed
- 1 teaspoon sea salt
- Freshly ground black pepper
- Juice and zest of 1 lemon
- Juice and zest of 1 orange
- 3 tablespoons tahini

Preheat the oven to 400°F. Cover a baking sheet with parchment paper.

In a large bowl, whisk together 4 tablespoons of the oil, the honey, cumin, coriander and chile flakes.

Slice the carrots into ¼" pieces, then add them and the unpeeled garlic to the spiced oil. Toss to coat well and season with salt and pepper. Scrape the dressed carrots onto the parchment-lined baking sheet and spread in a single layer. Roast, turning once, until the carrots are tender and caramelized, about 30 minutes.

Cool slightly, then transfer the roasted carrots to a food processor, slipping the garlic cloves out of their skins as you do so and scraping as much of the crusty brown bits, spices and oil as possible into the food processor. Add the lemon and orange zest and juice, the tahini and the remaining 2 tablespoons of oil. Puree until smooth. Taste and adjust the seasoning as needed.

Transfer to a serving dish and lightly drizzle with olive oil. Serve with bread, crackers and crudité's.
