





FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS At Bethel Woods, we strive to provide all our guests with a safe, comfortable, and enjoyable atmosphere.

BAG POLICY:

Guests will be able to carry only the following style and size bag, package, or container into the venue and will be subject to an extended security search:

- Clear bags made of plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12." Items in the bag must be in clear plastic bags. (Ziploc bag or similar).
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziploc bag or similar).
- Small clutch bags, approximately the size of a hand, with or without a handle or strap can be taken into the venue with one of the clear plastic bags. An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection. Please contact security at least 24 hours in advance to request an exception at 845-583-2062.
- Prohibited items include, but are not limited to: purses larger than a clutch bag, hard or soft coolers, briefcases, luggage of any kind, computer bags and camera bags or any bag larger than the permissible size.
- Clear bags are available for purchase at the Museum Shop, as well as at the main gates on concert dates, in the parking lots, and at the front gate merchandise tent.
- There will be express entry lanes available for those who travel light!

PERMITTED ITEMS:

Guests are welcome to bring the following into Bethel Woods:

- Blankets
- Clear tote bags not to exceed 12"x6"x12"
- Small clutch purses no larger than 5.5x8.5" (palm size)
- Hand-held umbrellas are allowed. No beach style or ground mounted umbrellas are permitted.
- Small hand-held cameras that fit in the pocket of jeans. Larger cameras, including professional cameras with multiple lens capabilities, are NOT permitted. Based on the restrictions of certain artists, this policy may vary.
- Stroller Wagons with Brakes (for children)
- Food one 1 gallon clear zip lock bag per person
- Water (Revised March 2023)

PROHIBITED

- Unsealed plastic water bottles of any size
- Metal/aluminum/non-plastic and glass reusable water or non-alcoholic bottles and cans, e.g. Yeti, Thermos, HydroFlask, canned sodas, etc.
- Alcoholic beverages of any kind

PERMITTED:

- A limit of two (2) factory sealed plastic water bottles (20 oz. or less) per person
- A limit of one (1) empty, reusable non-metal/non-aluminum water bottle e.g., Nalgene bottles, Camelbaks, etc. (32 oz. or less) per person
- Some artists may have more specific policies, such as the removal of lids or only allowing crushable, disposable bottles. We will do our best to communicate these policies as soon as we are made aware of them.
- Bethel Woods Souvenir Cup: The official Bethel Woods souvenir cup is a
 permitted item at Pavilion Concert entry, as per the reusable cup policy.
 Therefore, the Souvenir Cup can be reused outside of the cup purchase
 date. Refills can be redeemed throughout the Pavilion season (\$8.00 Cup |
 \$2.00 Refills)

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

- Lawn chairs (you may rent a lawn chair from us to use during a concert, however)
- Beverage Items (Revised March 2023)
 - Unsealed plastic water bottles of any size
 - Metal/aluminum/non-plastic and glass reusable water or non-alcoholic bottles and cans, e.g. Yeti, Thermos, HydroFlask, canned sodas, etc.
 - Travel mugs / plastic water jugs / bottles
 - Alcoholic beverages of any kind
- Sporting equipment (including roller-blades, skateboards, bikes, hoverboards, and segways)
- Bags including but not limited to: purses larger than a clutch bag, hard or soft coolers, briefcases, backpacks, luggage of any kind, computer bags and camera bags or any bag larger than the permissible size.
- Beach style umbrellas
- Aerosol cans including bug spray and sunscreen
- Firearms, knives, fireworks
- Glass of any kind (including bottles)
- Laser pointers
- Hula Hoops
- Selfie Sticks
- Audio and video recording equipment
- Drones or unmanned aerial vehicles
- Tablets (including but not limited to iPads and Kindles as they are a distraction to other guests and the artists)
- The use of charcoal grills are not permitted in the parking lots. Gas grills are permitted for use in the parking lots ONLY.

SEASON LAWN PASS:

Presented by Fun Wine

Q: What is a Season Lawn Pass?

A: A Season Lawn Pass guarantees your place on the lawn all summer, valid for general admission for the lawn for all Pavilion concerts, including "Pavilion Only" and SOLD OUT shows. It also includes a free lawn chair rental at each concert and is transferable, so you can share it with friends, family or co-workers. (Valid for one admission per event only).

Q: When will I receive my lawn pass?

A: Lawn Passes are now 100% digital. All tickets are available on your phone. Please visit http://am.ticketmaster.com/bethel/

Q: When can I start using my pass?

A: Your Season Lawn Pass will activate at the first publicly scheduled Pavilion concert in the 2023 summer season at Bethel Woods. Check our calendar and watch your email for upcoming announcements.*

* THE SEASON LAWN PASS IS NOT VALID FOR ADMISSION TO PRIVATE EVENTS, FESTIVALS, THIRD-PARTY RENTALS, THE MUSEUM, OR ANY PERFORMANCES OUTSIDE THE PAVILION AMPHITHEATER.

Q: Who can I contact if I have questions or concerns about using my lawn pass? **A:** Email us at lawnpass@bethelwoodscenter.org or call (845) 583-2000.

Q: Is my lawn pass transferable?

A: We look forward to seeing you at every show. However, if you can't make it, feel free to "pass" your Season Lawn Pass to a friend or family member. Remember, it can only be used once per event.

Q: Can I use it more than once per event?

A: No. Your Lawn Pass will only work once at the main gates. It has a unique bar code that is recognized and registered once you enter the venue. No re-entry privileges apply. One pass per person required for admission.

Q: Can I upgrade to reserved seating during a performance?

A: Yes, when available. If you are interested in moving to a reserved seat while you are at a show, please visit the box office or lawn chair booth. You will receive a credit towards the price of the selected reserved seat. Reserved seat upgrades day of show only and based on availability.

Q: Can I go backstage with my lawn pass?

A: No. The backstage area is a professional environment for working staff, management and performers only.

Q: Does the lawn pass reserve my place on the lawn?

A: Yes. The Lawn Pass will guarantee your admittance to the lawn, but does not guarantee an exact location as it is general admission seating only.

Q: Does the lawn pass get me into sold-out events?

A: Yes. As an added benefit of being a Lawn Pass holder, you will not have to worry about being shut out on sold-out shows.

MOBILE TICKETING:

As of March 2023, Bethel Woods is now mobile-only for ticketing.

Q: Why do you have SafeTix?

A: We believe every fan deserves access to tickets they can trust at every step. One of the best moments of attending live events is the excitement that builds when you get to the venue. No fan should ever experience being turned away due to a fake or counterfeit ticket. We're proud to power these moments and will continue to build, enhance, and deliver the safest way to attend your favorite events.

Q: How does Safetix work?

A: SafeTix uses new technology by tying a unique, identifiable digital ticket to your mobile phone through an encrypted barcode that automatically refreshes every few seconds. It also includes NFC technology that will allow fans to enter venues through a simple "tap and go" experience at venue entrances. These enhancements protect against tickets being screenshotted or photocopied and sold multiple times by shady resellers.

Q: Can I still enter my event with a screenshot of my ticket?

A: No. Your barcode includes leading-edge technology with fraud and counterfeit protection, so you won't be able to use screenshots or printouts. When you arrive at your event, use the Ticketmaster app or mobile website to locate your tickets. Your phone's your ticket, which you'll show to the ticket scanner, get your phone scanned – and you're in!

Q: I'm worried about my battery or cell service, what do I do?

A: If either is an issue, this ticket has you covered. Save your ticket to your apple or android wallet to access it even with limited or no cell service.

Q: Can I still print my tickets at home?

A: If you're using SafeTix, printouts and screenshots will not be accepted at entry. These tickets are powered by a new and unique barcode that automatically refreshes every 15 seconds so it cannot be stolen or copied, keeping your tickets safe and secure. 

Narrated by Nick & Bobbi Ercoline (the couple featured on the cover of the *Woodstock* album), the augmented reality tour shows visitors a 3-D model of the stage and pop-up photos and videos highlighting exciting landmarks around the historic site. Audio commentary from Nick and Bobbi is complemented by stories from Woodstock attendees, taken right from The Museum's archives.



Creating a fun, enjoyable, and explorative museum experience in an inclusive environment.

Sensory-Friendly Museum Days invite individuals of all ages with autism, complex developmental disabilities, or sensory sensitivities to experience the Main Exhibit, gift shop, and cafe during special early-morning hours before the museum opens to the general public.

Aspects of The Museum galleries have been adapted to give visitors control over their experience: sound and lighting features are augmented to reduce sensory stimulation; certain portions of the exhibit have been changed to give visitors the ability to engage to whatever extent they are comfortable. There are also props and costumes available for guests seeking a more tactile experience, as well as a Sensory Map, shown below.

We are dedicated to ensuring the full integration of individuals with disabilities who use our facilities and have trained staff and volunteers available to assist guests in navigating the exhibition, engaging in interactive explorations, and answering questions about any displays.




